<b>2005 Domaines Schlumberger Riesling Les Princes Abbés   Alsace   France</b>	<b>\$ 59</b>	
Domaine Schlumberger has built its reputation for producing classic Riesling. Dry, lingering finish, this beauty is pure pleasure - light to medium-bodied, aromas of peach, citrus and mineral flavours melding together.		
<b>2007 J. Lohr Bay Mist Riesling   Monterey County   California   USA</b>	<b>\$ 40</b>	<b>9.95</b>
The honey aroma lends itself to this crisp, off dry and mouth watering wine! With hints of melon and peach that inspire appetizing thoughts of Thai cuisine!		
<b>2007 Cave Spring Dry Riesling   Niagara   Ontario</b>	<b>\$ 38</b>	
Fresh grapefruit and pineapple on the nose with floral notes. Light to medium bodied, clean, and crisp with a sense of sweetness on the finish.		
<b>2007 Pierre Sparr <i>Extreme</i> Riesling   Alsace   France</b>	<b>\$ 36</b>	<b>8.50</b>
White flowers, citrus and green apple on the nose – flavours that follow on the palate to a crisp, lingering finish.		
<b>2007 Hardys Stamp Series Riesling-Gewürztraminer   Australia</b>	<b>\$ 32</b>	<b>7.50</b>
Fresh, medium dry with crisp balancing acidity. Lifted aromas of Lychee, limes and spice with matching flavours. Best with spicy dishes.

Crisp refreshing oasis of citrus, fresh green apple   hint of jasmine – brilliant finish.		
<b>2008 Kim Crawford Sauvignon Blanc   Marlborough   New Zealand</b>	<b>\$ 49</b>	<b>10.95</b>
All the classic flavours and aromas we have come to expect such as gooseberry, peapods, asparagus, passion fruit and citrus. Tantalizing with seafood and stir fry with fresh basil. The palate balances intense fruit qualities. Endless Varietal character.

<b>2006 Sonoma Cutrer Chardonnay   Sonoma Coast   California   USA</b>	<b>\$ 65</b>	
Rated the most popular Chardonnay in Wine & Spirits' 2009 Annual U.S. Restaurant Poll, this is Sonoma-Cutrer's flagship wine. Complete malolactic fermentation done entirely in barrel give this wine its buttery, rich texture and its oaky profile. This medium-bodied Chard serves up flavours of tropical fruit, citrus, florals embossed by voluptuous vanilla, butter and light spice. According to Wine Enthusiast: "Here's a rich Chardonnay. It's upfront in pineapple pie, peach cobbler, apple butter, yet is dry and pleasantly crisp in acidity".		
<b>2007 Wente Morning Fog Chardonnay   Livermore Valley   California   USA</b>	<b>\$ 45</b>	<b>9.95</b>
Apple and pear aromas with mineral and oaky notes; round fruit flavours with a citrusy finish.		
<b>2007 Tempus Two Copper Wilde Chardonnay   Adelaide Hills   Australia</b>	<b>\$ 43</b>	
A stylish Chardonnay with good length and lovely classic fruit and oak nuances on the finish making it very easy drinking. Delicate aromas of apple and pear, with hints of oak. Full-bodied, with lovely flavours of gooseberry and herbal aromas; tangy and just off dry, with good fullness-of-palate flavour, is the hallmark of <b>Tempus Two Winery</b> .		
<b>2008 Cono Sur Viognier   Colchagua Valley   Chile</b>	<b>\$ 29</b>	<b>7.50</b>
Tropical fruit aromas with melon, peach and orange blossom notes; dry, medium bodied, with great acidity and flavours of grapefruit, green apple and pineapple; good length on the finish. Perfect with stir-fry or wok-sautéed white meats, vegetables		
<b>2007 Ironstone Vineyards Symphony Obsession   California   USA</b>	<b>\$ 39</b>	<b>9.95</b>
Extremely drinkable, this lusciously brilliant and fanciful wine is full of fruit flavours, and finishes crisp and clean. The ripe taste is only a little sweet, with the tartness of fresh pineapple or apricot and a lush mouth feel. It is great with spicy dishes, like Asian foods.		
<b>Red Wine</b>		
<b>2007 Stoneleigh Pinot Noir   Marlborough   New Zealand</b>	<b>\$ 49</b>	<b>10.95</b>
The bouquet is fragrant, with black cherry and red plums overlaid with savoury toasty spice and fine, favourable oak. Superbly balanced wrapped in gentle tannins and a remarkable breadth of delicious dry acidity. The palate continues long and ripe with smooth dark red berry fruit characters. Inimitably suited to cuisine with mushrooms and exotic flavours.		
<b>2007 Fontanafredda Barbera D'alba Briccotondo   Piedmont   Italy</b>	<b>\$ 42</b>	
This Barbera may be the best value to come out of Piedmont. Medium full-bodied with a plush texture leading to a lengthy finish with depth of flavour. Delicious. Score of 90 and was on the Wine Spectator top 100 wines.		
<b>2007 J. Lohr Seven Oaks Cabernet Sauvignon   California   USA</b>	<b>\$ 49</b>	<b>10.95</b>
This densely coloured red is packed with intense aromas of black cherry, blackcurrant, cedar, vanilla, and spices. Full-bodied and sweet-centred, this Cabernet will pair beautifully with roasted or grilled red meats.		
<b>2006 Armador Cabernet Sauvignon   Maipo Valley   Chile</b>	<b>\$ 38</b>	<b>8.50</b>
Deep aromatics greet the nose with lively notes of ripe black fruit; expression of rich, red fruit flavours, cocoa with plum intertwined. This is a well-balanced medium to full flavoured wine that delights the senses.		
<b>2007 Heartland Stickleback Red Shiraz-Cabernet Sauvignon   South Australia</b>	<b>\$ 39</b>	
Bright, ripe and jazzy, adding a nice accent to the cherry, cranberry and spice flavours, lingering on the polished finish thanks to a blend of Dolcetto and Grenache.		
<b>2006 Jim Barry THE LODGEHILL Shiraz   South Australia</b>	<b>\$ 69</b>	
Won Gold Medal at prestigious Int'l Wine Challenge 2008 in London, UK. Bright and effusive, spicy note as the blackberry and red cherry flavours pop. Score 91 Harvey Steinman, Wine Spectator. "Editors' Choice" from the Wine Enthusiast: "This full-bodied, supple textured Shiraz out punches its weight class, offering licorice & blackberry aromas and fruit-driven flavours on the knockout finish."

Aromas of spicy blueberry and plum. Rich, generous flavours of fruitcake rounded off by soft tannins, balanced acidity and a long finish. Best enjoyed with full flavoured foods including duck, lamb and beef.		
<b>2006 Blackstone Merlot   Monterey County   California   USA</b>	<b>\$ 39</b>	<b>9.95</b>
Blackberry aromas, cherry flavour with a hint of cocoa and a mint makes this wine a great sipper as well as with many of our dishes! Elegant, well balanced, supple oak characters and soft tannins makes this a crowd favourite.		
<b>2006 Sterling Vintner's Merlot   California   USA</b>	<b>\$ 38</b>	
Exquisite Merlot for the value! Opaque ruby colour; scents of ripe blackberry; medium to full bodied, soft, silky tannins, ripe black fruit on the palate. Matches with our wok fries and Thai beef dishes.
